OTHER TIPS & INFORMATION

- **Passport & Visas** – A passport with at least one blank page and minimum validity of six months from the date of entry is required. Visa can be obtained online via <http://www.eta.gov.lk/slvisa/>
- **Currency Exchange/Credit Cards** – Sri Lankan rupees (Rs.) are the local currency, and currency can be exchanged at bank counters in the arrival lounge. Currency exchange is also available at numerous certified money changers and banks throughout the country. Larger hotels, stores, and restaurants normally take all major credit cards.
- **General Behavior** – Sri Lanka is a highly conservative country in general, therefore be respectful of the culture and other religions. When visiting sacred sites such as temples/shrines or any place of worship, you must dress appropriately (covering all portions of your body).
- **Climate/Clothing** – Most of the island is hot and humid, therefore light cotton clothing and comfy shoes are recommended for walking/trekking. Because the hill country can get a little cool at night, bring a light sweater with you.
- **Electricity** – The voltage is 230-240V. Round three-pin sockets are the norm, while square three-pin sockets are occasionally found, particularly in more upscale hotels. Adapters are inexpensive and frequently accessible.
- **Health** – Bring mosquito repellent, sunblock or tan lotion, and any medications you may require for your vacation. They are available locally in supermarkets and pharmacies, but it is advisable to bring your own if you are familiar with specific brands.
- **Festivals/Public Holidays** – Sri Lanka is a country full with festivities and celebrations. You can find out about upcoming events before you arrive in the nation. On all Poya (full moon) days and religious holidays, the sale and drinking of alcohol is forbidden.
- **Tipping** – Tipping your chauffeur guide is entirely up to you. If you are pleased with your chauffeur guide's service and wish to tip him, we propose a daily tip of USD\$10.
